CCTV System to be delivered by 30 June 2018

The Town of Gawler is pleased to announce that South Australian business MIMP Connecting Solutions has been engaged to deliver an upgrade to the Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) system in Gawler.

The CCTV system will include the installation of high definition cameras at identified 'hot spot' locations within Murray Street and surrounding precincts as identified in consultation with South Australia Police, local businesses and the community.

The new system will provide comprehensive coverage and link directly to the Gawler Police Station. This improved coverage and access will allow real-time viewing of high-definition footage assisting with the effective management of crime, vandalism, accidents and anti-social behaviour in Gawler.

Mayor Redman said, "Strong communities are underpinned by safe environments. With modern real time CCTV systems in place we can all enjoy everything Gawler has to offer".

Council received \$100,000 in funding from the State Government Attorney General's Department as a contribution towards delivering the upgraded CCTV system.

MIMP Connecting Solutions was selected as the preferred supplier following an open market call in late 2017. Works will commence in the coming weeks with installation to be completed by 30 June 2018.
