The park, which has separate areas for both large and small dogs, coped very well with the numbers with dogs of all shapes, sizes, breeds and colours enjoying their new space. It was great to see them running around and socialising with each other, owners were delighted with this new well designed space”, said Mayor Redman.

Mayor Redman continued, “Given the close proximity of the Dog Park to Hewett residents, the Light Regional Council has generously offered a financial contribution towards the annual maintenance of the Dog Park. What a wonderful way for our two Councils to come together and provide a facility for the residents and visitors to both of our Council areas.”

Council first identified the need for a dog park in November 2015. After community consultation and in conjunction with assistance from the community, the dog park finally came to fruition this month. Combined with the Fitness Trail, this is the first of its kind for the Gawler Community.
