## Release of Rural Land and Infrastructure Investigation Report 2 and Rural Areas Statement of Intent for Public Consultation

At its March Council meeting, Council resolved to continue pursuing refinement to land use policy within the Rural Zone.

*“A significant part of progressing this work is to engage with our community to better understand their thoughts regarding the investigations undertaken to date, as well as their general desires for this area”* said Mayor Redman.

Council are pleased to invite the community to share their view on the Rural Land Use and Infrastructure Investigation Report 2 prepared by Jensen Planning and Design as well as the Rural Areas Statement of Intent (SOI).

The subject documents have been released for community consultation until COB 24 May 2019. The documents can be accessed via Council’s website and/or hard-copies will be available to view from the Gawler Administration Centre located at 43 High Street, Gawler East and Evanston Gardens Community Centre 65 Angle Vale Road, Evanston Gardens.

The Rural Areas SOI expresses Council’s desire to amend land use policies within the Rural Zone in accordance with the vision and set of guiding principles adopted by Council following community consultation on Rural Land Use and infrastructure Investigation Report 1.

The Rural Land Use and Infrastructure Investigation Report 2 – Policy Recommendations is simply a reference document that has not been formally endorsed by Council, and has no legal status under the State Planning System.

A date for this future Infrastructure and Environmental Services Committee will be advised at the conclusion of the consultation period.

*“The information gathered from this consultation period will be presented to the Infrastructure and Environmental Services Committee and assist Council in future deliberations about possible refinement to land use policy in the Rural Zone”* - said Mayor Redman.
