Willaston Nature Playspace - Elliot Goodger Memorial Park

The Town of Gawler is pleased to announce the start of construction of the new Willaston Nature Playspace at Elliot Goodger Memorial Park

This playground is identified in the Gawler Open Space, Sport and Recreation Plan, which was adopted in 2016, as a gap in the needs of our community. Through consultation with the local Willaston community in 2018, the location of the play space was decided and informed the final play element design. The playspace construction contract has been awarded to LCS Landscapes, who have now commenced works on the project.

Mayor Karen Redman said, "This Nature Playspace provides exciting new facilities for families within our community. The playspace will include accessible elements such as a basket swing, mound slide and cubby as well as timber stepping logs, scramble mound with tunnel, timber balance logs and a rope climbing net, all set amongst a native landscape with mature trees. Whilst at the playspace, families can enjoy the use of a new shelter with picnic table and the recently completed adjoining BMX Pump Track".

The construction of playspace is expected to be completed by the end of 2019 in anticipation of the school holidays for local kids to enjoy this new facility.
