

COMMUNITY CONSULTATION & FEEDBACK

The Julian Terrace and Apex Park Toilet Development forms part of the strategic delivery of the Gawler Town Centre Design Framework that Council endorsed in 2016 to provide an ongoing commitment to the vitality of the Town Centre.

As part of the Walker Place Redevelopment new public toilets are to be delivered to replace the existing toilets located along Julian/Whitelaw Terrace (opposite Walker Place) that are at the end of asset life.

As there is existing community artwork attached to the Julian/Whitelaw Terrace public toilets that will be demolished, Council propose new open space that retains the artwork and increases the amenity of Julian Terrace.

The demolition of existing toilets, retention of community artwork and development of new public toilets is being funded in collaboration with the State Government as part of the Walker Place Redevelopment 'Places for People' grant.



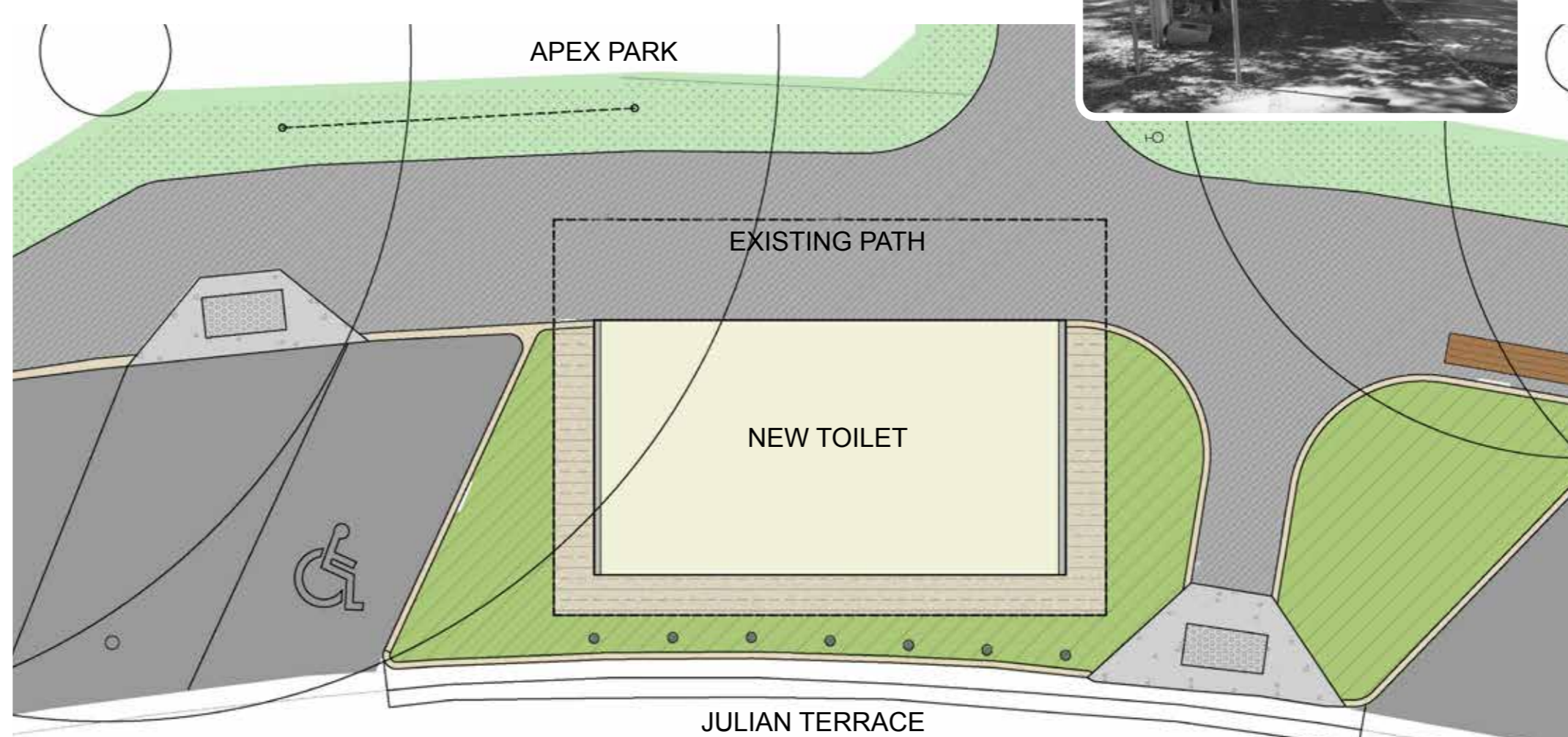
APEX PARK TOILET DEVELOPMENT



The new toilet at Apex Park will provide **four unisex cubicles and one disability accessible toilet**.

The development of the new public toilet will include **two disability parking spaces**, garden beds, new kerb ramps and seating benches.

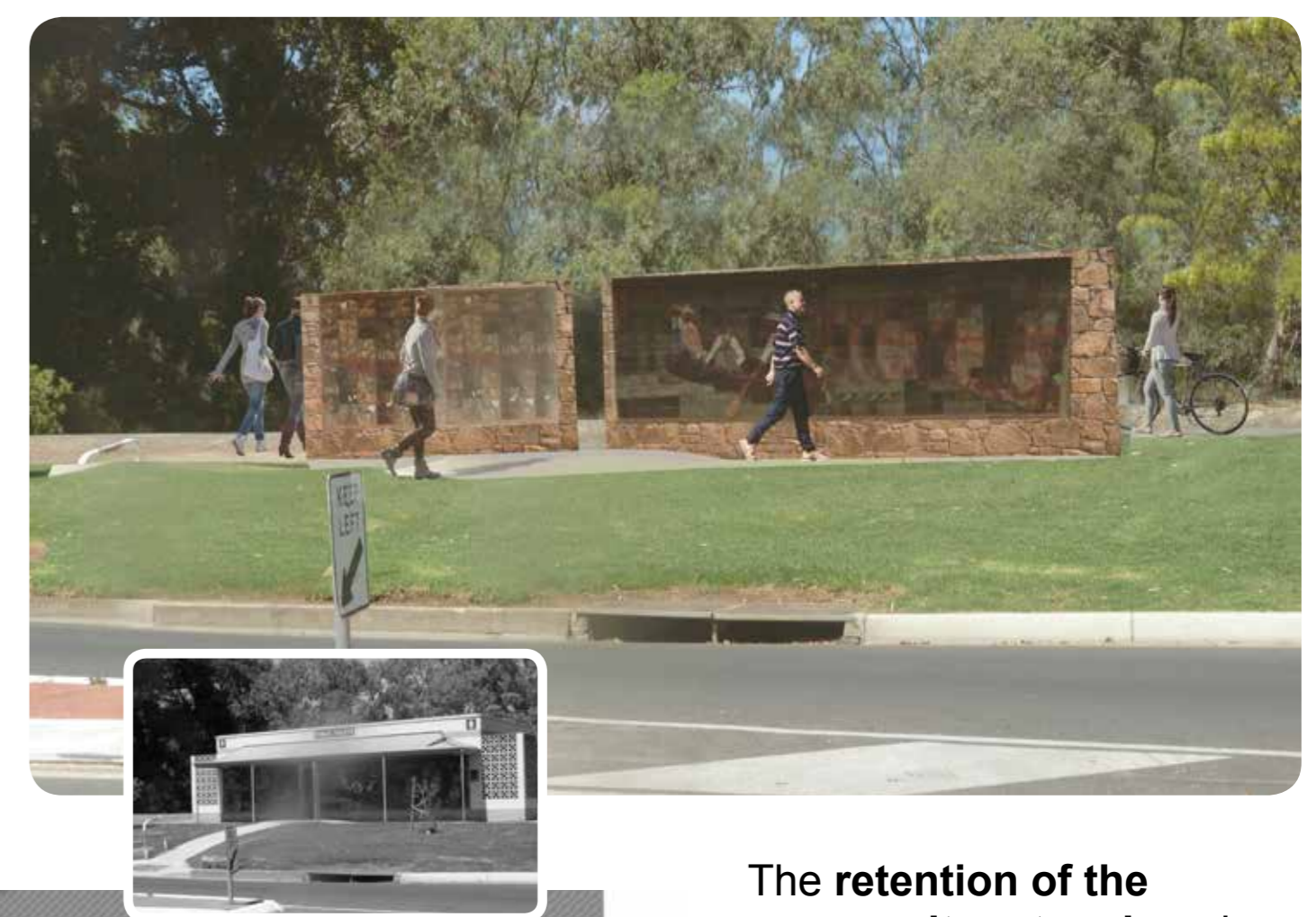
The proposed facilities will provide additional amenities that will **support events and other community activities** in Apex Park

RETENTION OF COMMUNITY ARTWORK



The **retention of the community artwork** and removal of the existing toilet will create a public space for Julian Terrace.

New **seating areas, garden beds and pathways** will provide access and amenity, while the **retention of the mural** will reinforce the community value of the artwork.
