Trial Hard Waste Service Terms and Conditions

To be eligible to apply for the Hard Waste Trial you must be a Town of Gawler resident and Australian Government Pensioner Concession Card holder in receipt of one of the following payments from the Commonwealth Government:

- Age Pension
- Bereavement Allowance
- Carer Payment
- Disability Support Pension

The Hard Waste Trial will be limited to up to 460 services on a first-in basis, with each property able dispose of up to 2 cubic metres of eligible material, or one 2.1m x 1.5m x 2.0m single-axle (caged) trailer load. Only one service is allowable per property, and must be redeemed by 31 May 2019.

Successful applicants have the ability to choose to have up to 2 cubic metres of eligible hard waste material collected from their property on a predetermined collection day, or drop-off one 2.1m x 1.5m x 2.0m single-axle (caged) trailer load of eligible hard waste material to either:

- NAWMA Resource Recovery Centre on Bellchambers Road, Edinburgh North (Monday to Friday 8am to 4pm or Saturday and Sunday 9am-3pm),
- Eco Waste Solution 101 Kelly Road, Willaston (Monday to Friday 7am-5pm or Saturday 9am to 2pm)

Once your application is confirmed, NAWMA will coordinate your booking and advise you either via SMS or Email. If you elect to have your hard waste collected from your property all items must be placed out for collection before 7am on the predetermined pick-up day. Items must be neatly stacked inside your property boundary, not on the verge. Placement must also not impede pedestrian footpath access. Material placed out for collection must be easily lifted by two people and bags or boxes must be secure enough so they will not break open when lifted.

If you elect to drop-off your hard waste to one of the nominated drop-off destinations you must drive with you trailer to the Gate of the resource recovery centre.

ELIGIBLE /ACCEPTABLE HARD WASTE MATERIAL

1. Furniture including carpets (must be rolled up) and mattresses.
2. Refrigerators, stoves, washing machines, dishwashers & small kitchen appliances.
3. Domestic household Items: e.g. toys, bikes, empty clean paint tins (with lids removed), car rims (not tyres) and other scrap metal.
4. Electronic items (anything with a cord).
5. Timber no longer than 2m, free of nails and bundled.
6. Cardboard flattened & tied in bundles of 10 or less.

UNACCEPTABLE HARD WASTE

1. General household waste or clothing
2. Green waste.
3. Hazardous waste (e.g. asbestos, chemicals).
4. Car bodies/car parts. Broken glass.
5. Ammunition, explosives or gas bottles.
6. Paint tins containing wet paint.
7. Construction/building materials, rocks or dirt.
8. Car tyres and gas cylinders
9. No Commercial Waste or Rubbish from Businesses will be collected.

If waste is considered excessive or unacceptable and not collected/accepted a note will be left in the letterbox advising the resident. The following is considered to be illegal dumping and you may incur a fine:

- Placing items outside your property without a hard waste collection booking; or
- Placing items outside of other properties in the Council area.

IF YOU NEED TO CANCEL A HARD WASTE COLLECTION SERVICE

You must advise the NAWMA Customer Service Team on 1800 111 004 no later than 48 hours prior to your collection date if you wish to cancel your booking.
