DIY BIRTHDAY PARTY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Learners Pool - Shaded Area

50m Shallow end - Shaded Area

- 1. \$30 deposit is non refundable
- Birthday parties are not to start before 11.30am on Saturdays and Sundays. For parties
 during the week over the school holiday period please contact our program coordinator
 for availability.
- 3. Any children under the age 5 years must have a parent in the water within arm's reach at all times
- 4. A list of children names that the birthday party parents are paying entry for must be given to the kiosk staff on arrival once all children have arrived parent of birthday party child is to pay entry

FILMING AND PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

- 1. The use of all electronic devices in change room areas is strictly prohibited.
- 2. Any person requesting the use of an electronic device for photography or to film someone must agree and sign the electronic devices consent form available at the Kiosk. During this process the person will show a valid form of ID to a Gawler Aquatic Centre Staff Member and allow for their details to be recorded in our database.
- Upon signing and agreeing to the terms and conditions the person will be issued with a red wristband which identifies them to the public and staff as having read and understood the terms and conditions of electronic device policy.
- 4. Anyone without a red wristband taking photos or filming will be asked to cease doing so and asked to comply with the current policy. In suspicious circumstances the person using an electronic device may be asked to show management any photos and/or film they have allegedly taken, failure to do so may result in the police being called.

LOST PROPERTY

1. Lost property such as googles, swimwear or personal accessories is kept on site for a maximum of two weeks. After two weeks all googles, swimwear and personal accessories will be donated to charity. Personal accessories such as rings, wallets, phones will be kept in the safe for two weeks and handed over to the police after such time. We strictly prohibit loaning or handing out lost property.

LIGHTNING

1. The presence of lightning around an outdoor pool poses a serious safety risk. When lightning is within 10km of the Centre the Swimming Pool the water must be immediately evacuated. The "Flash-to-Bang" measurement of approximately 30 seconds between 'flash' and the 'bang' indicates that lightning is 10km away. Once lightning has moved 10km away or 30 minutes after the last thunderclap patrons may re-enter the water. Please be aware that no monetary refunds will be given to patrons in the event of an evacuation due to lightning.

POOL RULES

1. Please ensure you are following the pool rules at all times, follow the instructions of staff and enter the water in a safe manner at all times. The pool rules are in place for the enjoyment and safety of everyone at the Centre. The Watch Around Water Policy must be adhered to at all times. Enjoy yourself and please respect the personal space of others.

SWIM NAPPY POLICY

1. All children 3 and under are required to wear swim nappy at all times when they are in the water. This is to ensure patron safety and to maintain the highest possible water quality. Patrons will be asked to display evidence of a swim nappy at the pool entrance or at the start of their swimming lesson. Regular nappies do not qualify as swim nappies as they can swell and break open leaving unwanted gel in the water. Disposable or reusable swim nappies are available for purchase at the kiosk.

CANCELLATION OF BOOKING

- Gawler Aquatic Centre will not be held financially liable for any decision to cancel bookings due to unforeseen circumstances where the safety of patrons may come into question. This includes circumstances such as unforeseen plant and equipment failure, water chemistry problems, natural disasters or power outages.
- 2. As Gawler Aquatic Centre is an outdoor facility weather conditions have been considered for the cancellation of events. Events may be cancelled without incurring a cancellation fee only in extreme weather events. These are extreme storm conditions, lightning conditions and when temperatures exceed 38 degrees.
- A Hirer wishing to cancel a booking less than fourteen (14) days before the date of the booking remains liable for all charges due and will forfeit its deposit. All cancellations must be made in writing.

EQUIPMENT/ STRUCTURES

- Any equipment/ structures brought onsite by the user that have the potential to cause injury or damage is done so at hirers own risk. Persons assisting with setting up equipment do so at their own risk.
- Nothing is to be affixed to the walls, floors, fences or fixtures of the Pool without the approval of Centre staff.
- 3. The use of electrical equipment must be approved by Centre staff prior to the booking. All electrical equipment must have a current tag and test sticker affixed. No electrical equipment is permitted within 3 metres of the pool edge, wet or pedestrian areas (battery operated equipment is preferred).
