FRIDAY 31st JANUARY 2020

Mid-afternoon the PS Murray Princess departs historic Renmark, located in South Australia's Riverland region, and cruises under the Paringa Bridge. Enjoy a leisurely afternoon cruising downriver through the first of five locks we'll encounter on this cruise down to Mannum.

This evening we moor at the picturesque area of Pike River while you enjoy a Welcome Dinner. Our on-board entertainer provides music for the night owls.

SATURDAY 1st FEBRUARY 2020

We depart Pike River early morning & navigate through Lock 4 and the Kamikaze Flats. After lunch we arrive at the township of Loxton where you will step back in time at The Village. Here the stories are told of the region's early settlers and their families, displayed in over 45 recreated buildings and exhibits on the banks of the mighty Murray River.

We depart Loxton late afternoon and cruise downriver to Katarapko Creek for our overnight anchorage.

SUNDAY 2nd FEBRUARY 2020

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast and take in the tranquillity as the landscape slides by. This morning enjoy a special presentation and tastings of the bounty of food and wine produced in the Riverland region.

After lunch we secure at Kingston-on-Murray where you will visit the Cobdogla Irrigation and Steam Museum, the home of Australia's 'Big Thumper' Humphrey Pump. The world's only working Humphrey Pump has been lovingly restored and is demonstrated along with steam and diesel locomotives, steam traction or ploughing engines, oil engines, tractors and machinery from the early development era of the Irrigation Areas.

Late afternoon, the PS Murray Princess will navigate the 3rd lock on her journey on the way to Overland Corner. After dinner, join us for all the fun and excitement, and participate in our "Murray River Cup".

MONDAY 3rd FEBRUARY 2020

Continue cruising downriver this morning as you enjoy breakfast and take part in a Trivia Quiz.

After lunch, we arrive at Waikerie and walk ashore for some free time in the township or a visit to the Waikerie & Districts Machinery Preservation Society Museum.

Late afternoon we moor at an old distillery and after dinner, enjoy being entertained by our talented crew.

TUESDAY 4th FEBRUARY 2020

This morning we will negotiate Lock 2 before securing at Caudo Vineyard where we will enjoy cellar door tastings and a tour of the gardens & orchards.

This afternoon we secure the vessel at Morgan where we will hop ashore with the First Officer for a walking tour of this historic town. During the 1800's, Morgan was the home port of hundreds of paddle steamers which carried cargo and passengers up the Murray-Darling River system. The restored wharf precinct captures the early river trading days and the town's museums bring to life the stories of the paddle steamer era.

Early evening we depart Morgan and continue cruising downriver while you enjoy your delicious dinner and delight in the on-board entertainment.

This evening, we moor the PS Murray Princess at Donald Flat Lagoon for our overnight stay.

WEDNESDAY 5th FEBRUARY 2020

This morning we navigate Lock 1, the final lock of our journey while being entertained by a Trivia Quiz.

We arrive at picturesque Swan Reach late morning and join a guided walking tour of the township. The town was first settled in the 1850s and was originally the largest of five sheep and cattle stations in the area and is now home to native flower and fruit growers. You can choose to visit the Swan Reach Museum (gold coin donation at entry) or enjoy an ale or cappuccino overlooking the Murray River (additional cost) at the Swan Reach Hotel which was the original Swan Reach homestead.



Mid-afternoon we arrive at Sunnydale and it's all ashore for the Woolshed Show as we recreate typical Australian woolshed history. Later we visit the Native Wildlife Shelter where some of South Australia's most interesting native animals are cared for. And then of course, there is the great Aussie Barbecue – cooked and served in a bush setting on the banks of the mighty Murray River. An optional Nocturnal tour (additional cost) in a comfortable purpose built cart is available after dinner where you may see kangaroos, wombats, foxes, bats and owls.

THURSDAY 6th FEBRUARY 2020

After an optional Bush Tucker Breakfast (additional cost) or a bush walk with the Captain, we slowly cruise downriver past magnificent cliffs scoured by the river over millions of years. We reach Ngaut Ngaut Aboriginal Reserve, one of Australia's most significant archaeological sites, for a step back in time – tens of thousands of years – for a guided boardwalk tour to view ancient rock carvings and to learn about aboriginal history in the area.

We return to the vessel to cruise downriver to River View Lodge (near Piggy Flat / Coolcha). Along the way, enjoy a special presentation and tasting of the bounty of food and wine produced in the Riverland or inspect the wheelhouse with the Captain.

Tonight the Captain and his officers host a spectacular farewell Captain's Buffet Dinner. Dress up and dance, if you wish.

FRIDAY 7th FEBRUARY 2020

We arrive in the historic town of Mannum and after breakfast, and reluctantly say farewell as we arrive at the Mannum Wharf at 9am.



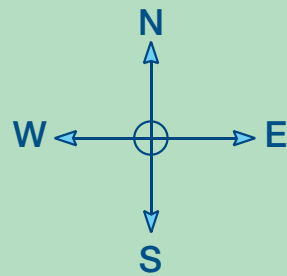


MURRAY PRINCESS 7 NIGHT RENMARK TO MANNUM CRUISE MAP
