

## MURRAY PRINCESS 7 NIGHT RENMARK TO MANNUM CRUISE

Cruise Departs Renmark at 3:30pm on Friday 31st January 2020. The cruise returns to Mannum on the following Friday 7th February 2020 at 9.00am.

### FRIDAY 31st JANUARY 2020

Mid-afternoon the PS Murray Princess departs historic Renmark, located in South Australia's Riverland region, and cruises under the Paringa Bridge. Enjoy a leisurely afternoon cruising downriver through the first of five locks we'll encounter on this cruise down to Mannum.

This evening we moor at the picturesque area of Rumpagunya Creek while you enjoy a Welcome Dinner. Our on-board entertainer provides music for the night owls.

### SATURDAY 1st FEBRUARY 2020

We depart Rumpagunya Creek early morning & navigate through Lock 4 and the Kamikaze Flats. After lunch we arrive at the township of Loxton where you will step back in time at The Village. Here the stories are told of the region's early settlers and their families, displayed in over 45 recreated buildings and exhibits on the banks of the mighty Murray River.

We depart Loxton late afternoon and cruise downriver to Morook for our overnight anchorage.

### SUNDAY 2nd FEBRUARY 2020

This morning we cruise towards Kingston-on-Murray where you will visit the Cobdogla Irrigation and Steam Museum, the home of Australia's 'Big Thumper' Humphrey Pump. The world's only working Humphrey Pump has been lovingly restored and is demonstrated along with steam and diesel locomotives, steam traction or ploughing engines, oil engines, tractors and machinery from the early development era of the Irrigation Areas.

During lunch, the PS Murray Princess will navigate the 3rd lock on her journey on the way to Overland Corner.

Take a guided tour of Overland Corner and find out why it was a convenient watering place and camp site for the overlanders and drovers operating between New South Wales and the colony based in Adelaide in the early years of the 1800s. The Overland Corner Hotel has been restored by the National Trust of South Australia and has so many tales to tell.

This evening, enjoy the on-board entertainment.

### MONDAY 3rd FEBRUARY 2020

Experience the magic of the Murray River by participating in a scenic tender boat ride through the Banrock Station Wetlands.

Enjoy lunch and take in the tranquillity as the landscape slides by as we pass the picturesque town of Waikerie.

After dinner, and after dinner, enjoy the on-board entertainment.

### TUESDAY 4th FEBRUARY 2020

This morning we will negotiate Lock 2 before securing at Caudo Vineyard where we will enjoy cellar door tastings and a tour of the gardens and orchards.

This afternoon we secure the vessel at Morgan where we will hop ashore to see this historic town. During the 1800's, Morgan was the home port of hundreds of paddle steamers which carried cargo and passengers up the Murray-Darling River system. The restored wharf precinct captures the early river trading days and the town's museums bring to life the stories of the paddle steamer era. Delight in a fascinating guided walk of the township and the Morgan Living History Museum.

This evening, join the Captain for pre-dinner drinks (own expense) and after dinner, enjoy the on-board entertainment.

### WEDNESDAY 5th FEBRUARY 2020

Daybreak and time for the keen photographers to be out to capture the special light and the morning movement of wildlife. Prolific birdlife includes pelicans, wrens and swans. Enjoy a leisurely morning and lunch cruising downriver through Lock 1.

This afternoon we moor at Sunnydale and it's all ashore for the Woolshed Show as we recreate typical Australian woolshed history. Later we visit the Native Wildlife Shelter where some of South Australia's most interesting native animals are cared for. And then

of course, there is the great Aussie Barbecue – cooked and served in a bush setting on the banks of the mighty Murray River.

An optional Nocturnal tour in a comfortable purpose built cart is available after dinner where you may see kangaroos, wombats, foxes, bats and owls (additional cost).

### THURSDAY 6th FEBRUARY 2020

After an optional Bush Tucker Breakfast (additional cost) or a bush walk with the Captain, we slowly cruise downriver past magnificent cliffs scoured by the river over millions of years.

We reach Ngaut Ngaut Aboriginal Reserve, one of Australia's most significant archaeological sites, for a step back in time – tens of thousands of years – for a guided boardwalk tour to view ancient rock carvings and to learn about aboriginal history in the area.

We return to the vessel to cruise downriver to River View Lodge (near Piggy Flat / Coolcha). Along the way, enjoy a special presentation and tasting of the bounty of food and wine produced in the Riverland or inspect the wheelhouse with the Captain.

Tonight the Captain and his officers host a spectacular Farewell Captain's Buffet Dinner. Dress up and dance, if you wish.

### FRIDAY 7th FEBRUARY 2020

We head back to Mannum and after breakfast, we reluctantly say farewell as we arrive at the Mannum Wharf.





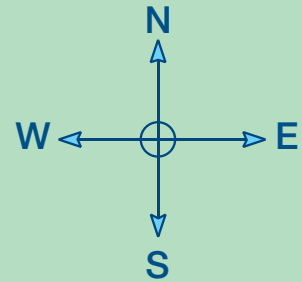


**MURRAY PRINCESS 7 NIGHT RENMARK TO MANNUM CRUISE MAP**
