

Open Academy at the Con - Rising Stars Bursary Program

The Sydney Conservatorium of Music is committed to ensuring that the study of music is available to all who wish to do so. To help facilitate this, the Conservatorium makes available a number of bursaries each year for the students in the Rising Stars program.

The bursaries are means tested i.e. are for families on low incomes. Parents seeking support by way of bursary should complete the attached application form and return it to the Open Academy.

A limited number of full bursaries are available supported by the Patricia H. Reid Endowment Trust. In addition, and subject to available funds, the Open Academy can offer additional bursaries to the value of 50% of the semester's fees. All Applications will be assessed the same way, and if a bursary is offered it only can be used to offset the fees of the core program (Instrumental Lessons, Music Skills Classes and Performance Practice). Bursaries are not available for elective courses (Chamber Music, Composition etc). The bursary will be for a period of one year and is subject to satisfactory performance by the student. Parents are welcome to reapply in subsequent years.

Information received in the application will be treated in the strictest confidence and in accordance with state privacy legislation.

Applications must be received by **Monday 12th January 2026.** If you are sending documents in the mail, please ensure you send them to arrive by this date. Late applications cannot be accepted.
