Farm notes

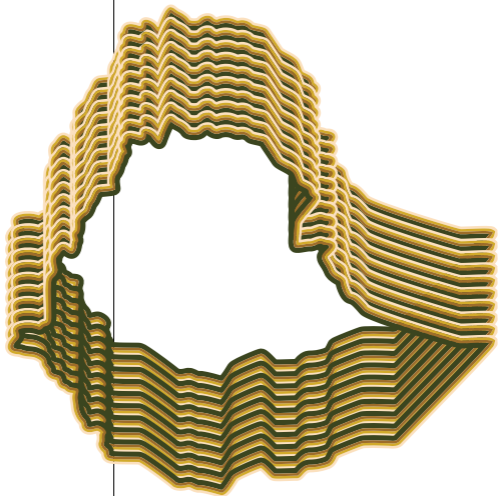
Dimtu is a privately owned washing station located in Oromia, West Guji, managed by husband and wife, Glzaw Alemayu and Frehiwot Mekonnen. Around 6,500 local small farmers deliver cherry to Dimtu with the average farm size around 1.5 hectares. Once coffee is delivered to the washing station it is dried on raised African beds for 12-20 days depending on the weather. To achieve the highest quality, Gizaw and Frehiwot have various purchase points in the surrounding areas where they select ripe cherries. This ensures a clean, sweet coffee.
