Little Saints- Preschool

Preschool story: Moses as a baby; Exodus 1-2:10

Memory verse: 'God has breathed life into all Scripture. It is useful for teaching us what is true.' 2 Timothy 3:16 (NIRV)

Preschool discussion:

The story of Moses happens after Joseph (Do you remember Joseph?) when God's people are slaves in Egypt and a different Pharaoh (king) is not being nice to God's people.

1. Why did Moses' mother hide Moses in the Nile river? (The Pharaoh wanted all Israelite baby boy killed so they would not grow up to fight him. Moses' mother wanted to protect him)
2. Who found Moses in the river? (Pharaoh's daughter)
3. Who took care of Moses? (God did)

God was in control of what happened to Moses, he had a plan for him, stay tuned...

Preschool prayer: Thank God that he has a plan for us and that we can trust him to take care of us as he cared for Moses!

Learn the Lord's Prayer: print the poster, decorate and share with us what you have done. Keep it for Term 2.
