Preschool discussion:

1. Have you ever changed your mind about something? Remember the plagues God sent on Egypt and that Pharaoh agreed to let the Israelites go. Then he changed his mind.
2. How did God take care of his people in the desert?
3. Can you think of something that is impossible? Nothing is impossible with God. God has a plan.
4. Have your plans ever been disrupted or cancelled? God's plan always comes true, isn't that amazing!
5. Have you ever walked through mud? Is it easy? The Israelites walked across dry land, isn't that amazing!

God makes a way where it seems impossible. Nothing gets in the way of God's plans. More next week.....

Preschool prayer: Thank God that he has a plan for us even when we can't see a way forward. Thank God that He is in control and can make impossible things happen.

Preschool craft:

Play: Recreate the parting of the Red sea using toys, create the sea using rice or building blocks. OR Create a fake river on the ground and lay out paper as stepping stones. Have your child cross the 'river' without stepping on the water.
