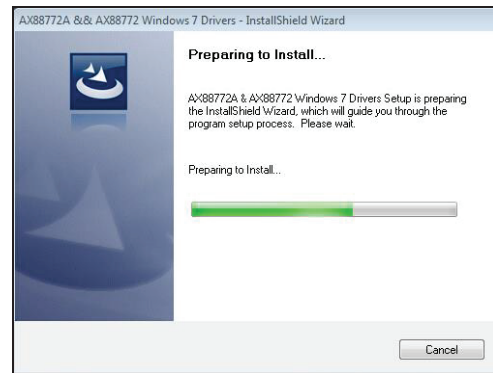

Driver Installation

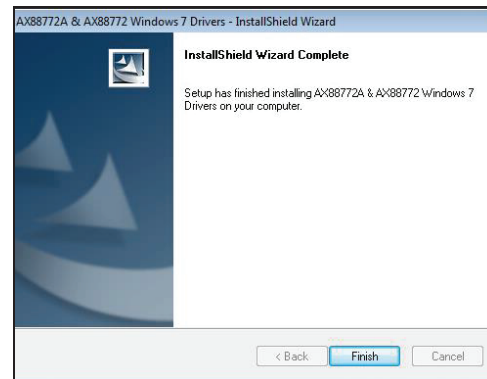
For Windows 10, Windows 8 and Mac OS X 10.5 or higher, you do not need to install drivers. Just plug in the USB to Ethernet Adapter and connect to your network.

For Windows 7/Vista/XP follow the steps below.

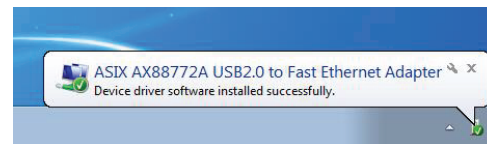
1. Do not connect the USB to Ethernet Adapter
2. Insert included CD into your disc drive
3. For Windows 7, double-click the **setup.exe** in the Win7 folder to launch the setup program
4. For Vista or XP, double-click the **setup.exe** in the WinXP folder to launch the setup program



5. This may take up to one minute

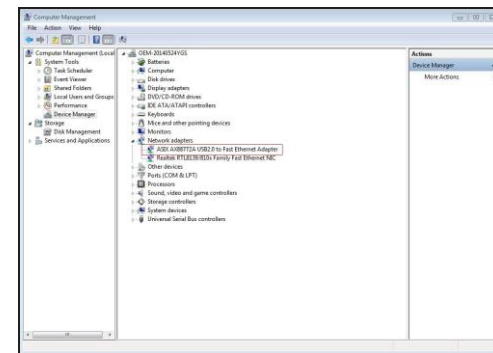


6. Click on 'Finish' to complete driver installation
7. Connect the USB to Ethernet Adapter to an available USB port
8. The following message should appear and you can now connect to your network



9. To verify your Ethernet adapter installation, you can open Device Manager by right-clicking the Computer icon on your desktop and selecting Properties > Device Manager.

Under **Network adapters**, you should see **ASIX AX88772A USB 2.0 to Fast Ethernet Adapter** as per below
