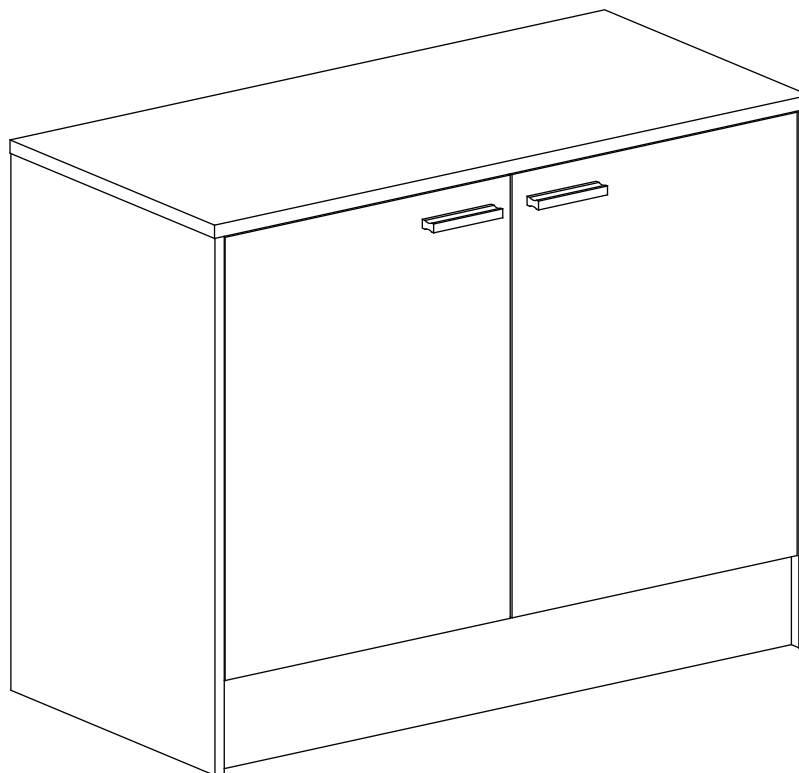

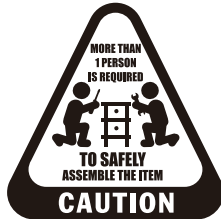

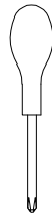

- Check that all bolts, screws and knobs are securely tightened at least every 4 months.

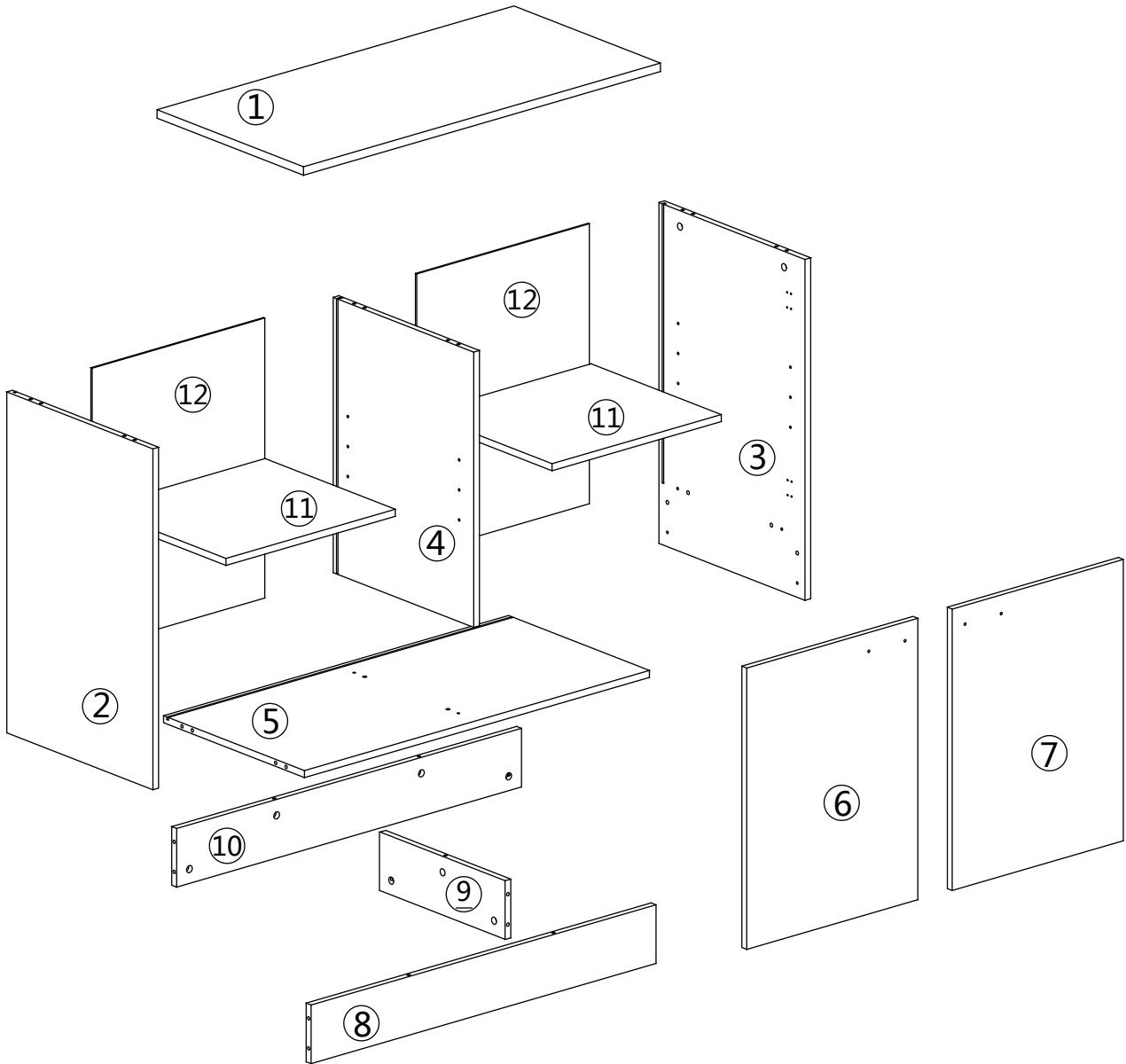

**IMPORTANT:** To prevent furniture from tilting forward it is recommended that you:

1. Prevent small children from climbing onto cupboard.
2. Securely attach the anti tilt straps provided to your wall.







**IMPORTANT:** For your safety when attaching the anti tilt straps:

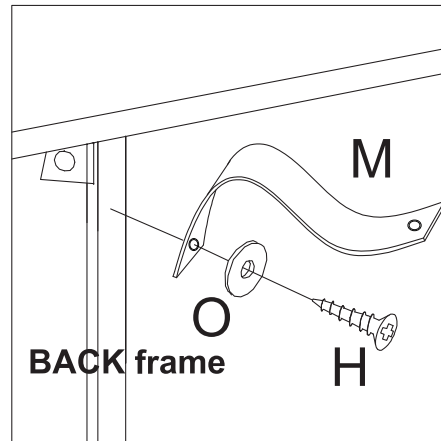
1. Check for any electrical wires or plumbing inside the wall before drilling any holes. If you are unsure please seek professional advice.
2. Walls are constructed from different materials such as masonry (solid brick) or plaster board lined cavity walls (hollow). It is important that you use the appropriate wall fixings for your wall type. Your local hardware store will have the necessary drills and fixings and can offer advice if needed.

### Anti-tilt furniture strap installation

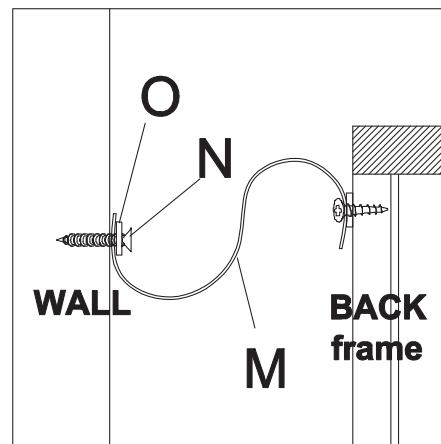
**IMPORTANT:** The wall fixing hardware supplied is for attaching to wall stud behind plaster board. For fixing directly to plaster board only or masonry please source the appropriate fixings from your local hardware store.

No	Name of Hardware	Q.ty
H	Screw (Ø3.5 x 14 mm) 	1pc
M	Strap 	1pc
N	Screw (Ø4 x 30 mm) 	1pc
O	Washer 	2pcs

1. Fix strap (M) to back frame by using hardware (H) and (O).



2. Position wall stud is in same level as back frame. Screw strap (M) into stud using hardware (O) and (N).

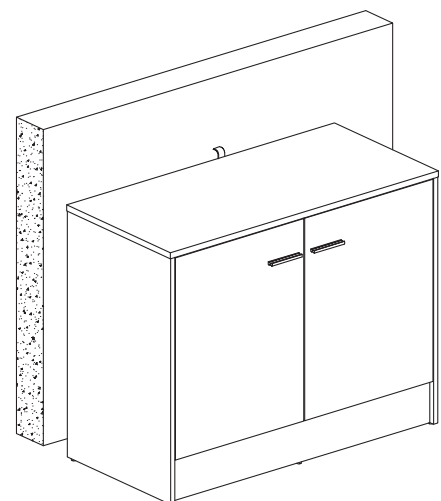


### Important Note

Do not push or pull the cupboard to reposition. This may result in broken legs.

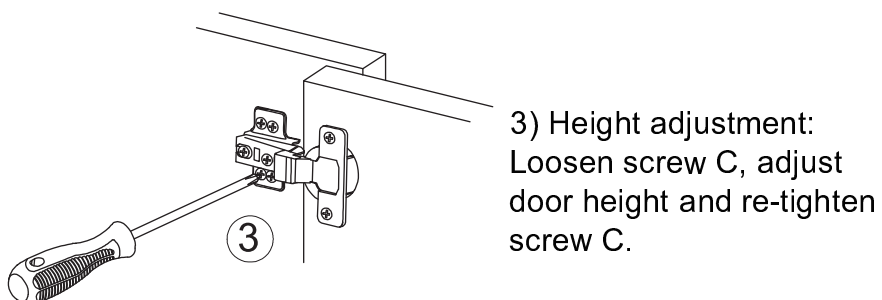
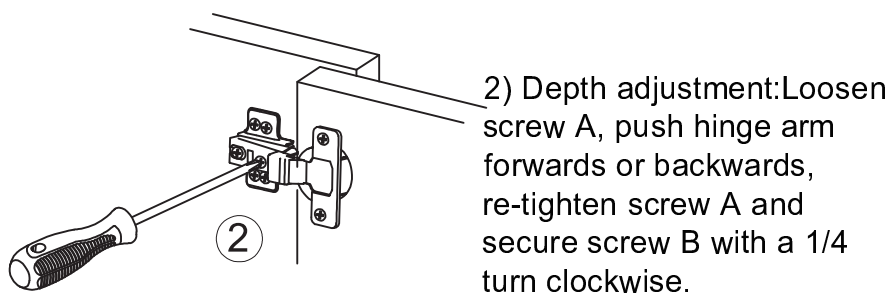
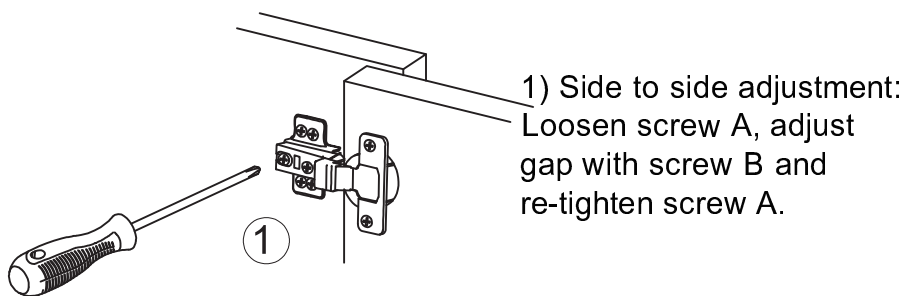
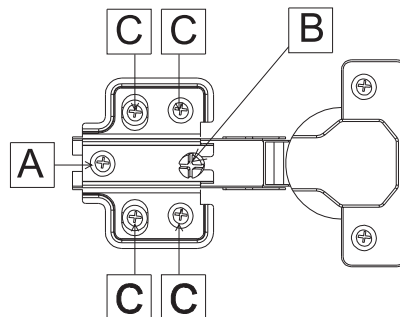
Always lift with a minimum of 2x people. Damage caused by dragging will void warranty.

Tighten screws and bolts after two weeks of use. Ensure screws and bolts remain tight by checking them several times a year.

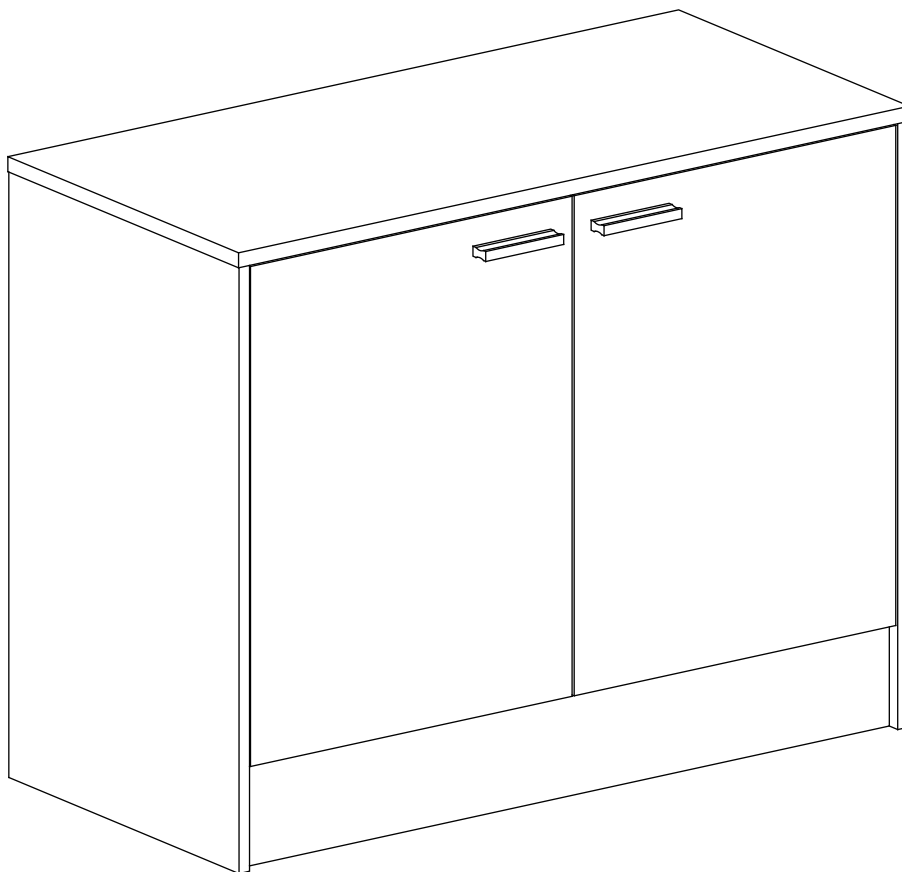


## Hinge adjustment

If the doors do not appear square or aligned, loosen or tighten the appropriate screws on each case hinge as illustrated.

# Care Advice

## Care Instructions - UV Finish CUPBOARD

- Keep away and protect from direct sunlight and heat.
- Do not place sharp materials(knife, fork, etc) directly onto your furniture as sharp material may scrape and damage the finish.
- Clean up spills quickly. Water left over a prolonged period of time may cause damage. Alcohol, perfume, nail polishes, aftershave and some medication may cause severe finish damage if not cleaned immediately.
- Use a clean, soft, dry, lint free absorbant cloth to clean your furniture. Do not use any detergent as they may contain ingredients that may react and damage the finish.
- Clean, check and tighten all parts regularly.

## Safety Warning

- DANGER – To prevent furniture from toppling attach, mount, bolt or otherwise secure to walls and floors. Do not put heavy items on top shelves of bookcases. Do not place unstable furniture near where children play.



- WARNING – This product is intended to hold the maximum weight indicated. Exceeding the maximum weight will result in instability and may cause injury.

## Warranty 3 years
