Do not crawl, lie or move around under the table frame,and do not sit or stand on the table frame.






How to use control panel

●	“▲”	Adjust the desk upwards
●	“▼”	Adjust the desk downwards

Operation

- Button Lift Function

Press the “▲” or “▼” button to adjust the height of the desk.

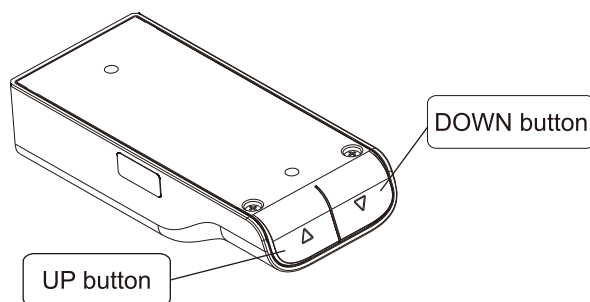
- Reset Function

(1) When the lifting system fails, release the button, long press the “▼” button, the reset will be finished until the lift system rebound and stop after reaching the bottom.

- Anti-Collision Safety System

The situation that lifting system meets obstacles will trigger this function and then please follow step (1). Press and hold buttons “▲” and “▼” for more than 5s to turn on or turn off anti-collision safety system.

If the anti-collision system is too sensitive, please check if the control panel was tightened with the desktop.



Common fault treatment

The following tips will help you detect and eliminate the common fault and error. If the fault you met is not listed below, please contact 1300 OFFICE (1300 633 423). Only the manufacturer and professionals are capable for investigating and correcting those fault and error.

Error Code	Description	Method
E01	Overwork	Please retry 18 mins later
E02	Overtemperature	Please retry 18 mins later
E03/E04	Overloaded	Please reset
E05/E06/E10	The legs cannot move in the process of rising or going down	Please reset
E07/E08/E20/E21/E22//E23	All the cables be connected well	Please reset
E09	The weight distribution on two sides of table is severely unbalanced.	Please reset



Attention

- 1.Power supply:AC100V-240V,50/60HZ
- 2.Service Environment:0-40℃
- 3.Unplug the power plug before cleaning, wipe the dust on surface with slight wet dishcloth when cleaning, be careful not to let the drops into the internal parts, not loose the connector.
- 4.The electric box contains electronic components, metals,plastics,wires etc., so dispose of it in accordance with each country's environmental legislation, not the general household waste
