4.0 First Aid Measures

Swallowed	DO NOT induce vomiting. May cause physical blockage of airways due to the pliable nature of the ointment. Ensure patient can breathe freely. The product should slowly melt at body temperature and is not anticipated to cause any toxicological distress. Seek medical advice where merited by symptoms.
Eye	The product is not anticipated to be specifically irritating. However, if irritation occurs, softly wipe excess away from eyes using a soft tissue or cloth; use running water to flush eyes free of ointment. If irritation occurs hold eyes open under running water for 15 minutes (removing contact lenses if merited) and seek medical advice as merited by the symptoms.
Skin	Not expected to be specifically irritating. If irritation does occur wipe away excess using soft cloth or tissue and then remove traces using mild vegetable oil and/or mild soap and water. Seek medical advice if merited by symptoms; see also section 16 – allergies.
Inhaled	Fumes and vapours are not anticipated to be irritating. Inhalation of semi-solid material may cause physical blockage of airways due to the pliable nature of the ointment. Ensure patient can breathe freely. Apply CPR where merited. The product should slowly melt at body temperature. Seek medical advice where merited by symptoms.
Advice to Doctor	Treat symptomatically.

Emergency Procedure	Spillage may result in staining of porous substances and/or hard surfaces becoming slippery. Take appropriate care.
Methods & Materials for containment and clean up	Wipe up excess using dry cloth or absorbent paper and dispose. Wash away excess using suitable detergent and hot water where appropriate. Ensure area is thoroughly clean and dry.

Precautions for Safe Handling	Store below 30°C. The tube contains a detachable tamper evident-seal that may be a choking hazard for small children. Take appropriate care when discarding this seal. Use appropriate hygienic practice when collecting product, ensure hands are clean and dry. Do NOT return unused product to container.
Safe Storage Practice	This is a medicine, store out of reach of children. Do not use after the expiry date. Protect from heat. Keep sealed in original container.

Conditions to avoid	Heat, light, strong chemicals and odours, fumes. Do not use or store in the presence of ignition sources (ie do not smoke while using). Packaging is combustible.

Swallowed - Acute	The product can be absorbed into the body by ingestion and is not anticipated to be harmful. Ingestion of large amounts may result in a slight laxative effect and/or digestive discomfort.
