

Usage


The electromotive, height-adjustable tables are designed for workstations in dry work environments only. The table height is infinitely adjustable, so that it can be set to the most ergonomically suitable working level.

They have not been designed for other purpose than those included in this manual, e.g., they are not to be used in ares of high humidity or dampness, not for lifting people. Any other use is at one's own risk!




















User guide



Notice

While raising or lowering the table, please make sure objects are secure on the table, and nothing prevents the table from raising or lowering through its desired range of adjustment.



Table Height Adjustment

Press up \bigcirc or down \bigcirc to raise or lower the table to the preferred table height.



Use of Memory Keys


In stationary state:

If you briefly press button ① and release it, the heightadjustable desk will move from the current height to the memory position 1.

If you briefly press button ② and release it, the height-adjustable desk will move from the current height to the memory position 2.

If you briefly press button ③ and release it, the height-adjustable desk will move from the current height to the memory position 3.


Memory Presets



If you press and hold button ① for more than three seconds, the current height will be set as memory position 1.

If you press and hold button ② for more than three seconds, the current height will be set as memory position 2.

If you press and hold button ③ for more than three seconds, the current height will be set as memory position 3.



♪

Pressing any key during the process of moving to a memory position will stop the system.

Abnormal reset protection



Phenomenon

After controller error occurs, the screen displays "rES" and none of the keys function.

Operation

After pressing (1) for 5 seconds, the height adjustable desk will start moving down until it reaches the bottom and then bounce back to a certain height. The reset is complete.

Protection and Alarm

Anti-interference: message/alarm "E02" appears when the desktop vibrates, is interfered with, or tilts during an adjustment. Stop adjustment immediately and reverse movement; after a certain adjustment the alarm will disappear.

Overheating protection: message/alarm "Hot" appears when continuous adjustment time exceeds 2 minutes, the overheating protection will be triggered. Stop adjustment immediately; wait for 18 minutes after which the alarm will disappear.

Motor malfunction protection: message/alarm "E10" appears. Power should be disconnected, re-check and ensure that the motor connected to the controller is secure, connect to power source, then press and hold the (\fill) to reset.

Overload protection: message/alarm "E20" appears when the table is raised while overloaded. Remove weight, heavy objects from the table before adjustments. If overload occurs when lowering the table, please press the $(\ ^{\downarrow})$ for 5+ seconds to reset.

Height inconsistency protection: message/alarm "E60" appears when the table is raised while the height between two columns is inconsistent. Power should be disconnected, re-check and ensure that the motor connected to the controller is secure, connect to power source, then press the (\$\frac{1}{2}\$) for 5+ seconds to reset.

Warranty 5 years

Product Warranty – valid for Australian customers only
