- The included screws and plastic anchors are suitable for plaster walls. Other mounting accessories for different wall types are available from your local hardware store.




- Phillips Head Screwdriver
- Spirit Level
- Drill
- Pencil
- Tape Measure


CAUTION: Do not use tools other than those required,
as this can damage the product .


Assembly Instructions:


- 1 Attach the acrylic holder to the board by removing the double sided tape and adhere to the back of the acrylic board.



- 2 Place the acrylic board horizontal on the wall, using the acrylic board holes as a template, Mark the hole positions with a pencil.


- 3 Drill holes on each of the marker positions on wall. Then hammer a plastic anchor into each hole.



- 4 Attach clip base to all 4 corners of acrylic board using screw 2. Secure screws into anchor 3 in the wall.


- 5 Attach the acrylic board clip cap to clip base as shown.



- 6 Place all 4 chalk markers 6 into the acrylic holder.




How to use the chalk marker:



1.Shake well



2.Press down for the ink to flow through nib



3.Write
