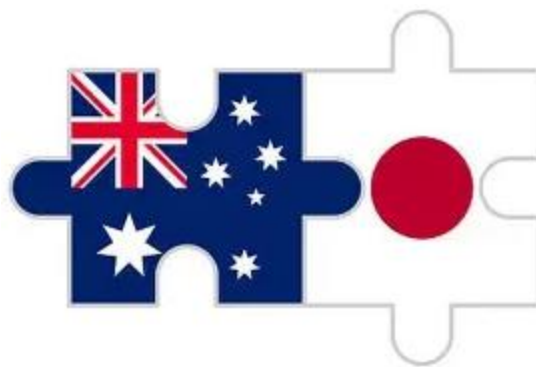
## LTQ Gold Coast Languages Speech Contest

Speaker Division Year 4, 5 and 6 Speech

**Year 4:** 「私の好きなこと」

**Year 5:** 「オーストラリアの好きなところと 日本の好きなところ」

**Year 6:** 「オーストラリアと日本とひかくすること」



**Time limit: approximately 1 minute. (no longer than 1.5 min)**

Students should start the speech with their name, school, and year level.

Questions: **Two** questions will be asked at the completion of the speech using similar language that was used in the speech and based on the speech content.

- Gestures should be restricted to bowing at greeting and farewell.
- Parents are welcome to sit in the judging room.
- Judges are two Japanese speakers.
- There is no audience apart from family.
- No video but photos are ok without flash.
- Students who have competed in previous contests should not use the same speech presented in previous years.
- The speech title should be noted on the Registration Form.
- Japanese background speakers from any school, not just schools studying Japanese, are welcome to register.
- Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 will be judged separately and only compete against their year.
- Judges and convenors decision is final.

Two questions will be asked at the completion of the speech. The language in the questions will be the same as the language used in the sentences. Please restrict gestures to bowing at opening and closing greetings.
