Dear Parent(s)/Caregiver(s)

Thank you for your support and understanding over the past week, particularly in relation to the mask-wearing requirement in schools, as well as the impact of restrictions on events and activities at the College, which will possibly continue to be the case in the near future.

It was pleasing to hear of the easing of restrictions announced at the Premier's conference today. The impact for schools and in particular Rostrevor College of these changes are listed below.

**From Thursday 5 August, the following activities can resume:**

- Whole school assemblies, Chapel and House gatherings;
- All co-curricular activities within the school including interschool sport training, trials and competitions;
- Incursions, excursions, and intrastate camps;
- Events held at offsite venues with approved COVID-19 safe or COVID-19 management plans;
- Events held within the College grounds (including performances, concerts and assemblies) providing:
  - Density requirements and physical distancing requirements are met by all attending adults. Note that when adults are present, distancing and density requirements apply to students as well and this will continue to limit parent attendance at some school events;
  - Masks are worn by adults and students in secondary school who are not performing;
  - All visitors to the College must complete a COVID-19 check in;
- Water safety/swimming/aquatic lessons.

The following measures **remain in place until further notice:**

- All interstate camps and travel is postponed;
- All staff and students in secondary schools must continue to wear masks;
- We will continue to limit the number of parents on site, and when on site parents must wear a face mask and practice physical distancing;
- All adults (including staff) must complete a COVID-19 check in each time they enter the site.

Michael Vickery, Director – Boarding will communicate any changes to Boarding House routines and activities as a result of the recent changes to restrictions.

Please note that due to the changing nature of the pandemic, as we have witnessed in other states, events, camps and excursions may be cancelled or postponed with minimal notice.
