



## BOARDING BURSARY INFORMATION SHEET

Boarding Bursaries are offered for rural students boarding at Rostrevor College. It is available to students from Years 8 to 12.

Rostrevor College believes that the school as a whole is enriched by a variety of cultural backgrounds, including rural, and indigenous students

This Bursary recognises a variety of talents of a rural student and his capacity to benefit from the nurturing of these gifts in Rostrevor's educational environment. Being a member of this environment offers the student an opportunity to develop and to contribute to the life of the College in the belief that students gain much for themselves in the experience of sharing their abilities with and for others.

Boarding Bursaries offer various levels of fee support depending on financial circumstances.

Rostrevor College Boarding Bursaries are generally accepted at the time of enrolment. As places in Duggan Boarding House can fill quickly and there is a ceiling on Boarding Bursaries, families are encouraged to lodge an early Enrolment Application and advise the Enrolments officer of an intention to apply for a Boarding Bursary.

Bursary applications should be sent to the Business Manager at least a few weeks prior to enrolment interview and should include:

- a completed Application for Boarding Bursary and any financial documents to support the application
- latest 2 school reports if not already submitted to the Enrolments officer with the correct forms.
- CV and letter from the student outlining his interests, skills or contribution to his community to be sent to the Enrolments officer.

All applicants must be interviewed by the Principal or his nominee. Families are welcome to contact the Business Manager prior to enrolment to discuss their financial and other family circumstances.

Boarding Bursaries are awarded year by year depending on the family's financial situation. If fee support is sought for the following year, families are asked to complete a new Application for Boarding Bursary each year. Bursaries are also subject to the student's contribution in Duggan House, educational performance and general participation in College life.

Recipients of the Boarding Bursary are required to pay for travel and incidentals such as bedding, medical costs, etc. They are also required to meet all other charges related to a student's education at the College, such as tuition fees, stationery, uniforms (including uniforms for sport) and the additional costs if the recipient chooses to participate in interstate sporting trips and music tuition. Students accepting Boarding Bursaries are required to meet the other enrolment criteria of the College with regards to philosophical and religious disposition.
