Code of Behaviour for Participants (as per the Student Planner)

- Co-operate with your coach, staff member, team-mates and opponents. Without them, there would be no competition.
- Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit, not just to please your parents and coaches.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.

All breaches of the above Code of Behaviour will be dealt with in accordance with the behaviour expectations of the school, having considered the guidelines followed by relevant sports associations and in consultation with the Director of Co-Curricular Programs and Deputy Principal – Dean of Students.
