Dear Parents/Caregivers

As you will be aware, SA will begin a 7-day lockdown at 6pm this evening as we respond to the increase in COVID-19 cases in our State.

From tomorrow, Wednesday 21 July 2021, Rostrevor College will be closed except for the care of children of essential workers or vulnerable children. Students who are required to attend will be supervised in the College's Equity Hub. As always, students should not attend if they are unwell or are required to self-isolate by SA Health. If you need to access this supervised College service, please register via this link: [Essential Worker Registration](#). The drop off point for all registered students will be the Middle/Senior Years entrance on Glen Stuart Road. Please note that the canteen will be closed.

Online/remote learning will commence on Thursday 22 July 2021, but students can continue to access their learning materials via SEQTA at any time. Reception - Year 3 students will continue their learning on Thursday via Class Dojo or SEQTA.

Today, your son/s have brought home materials and equipment they will need to continue their learning program.

From Thursday, all Middle and Senior Years students will be expected to engage in their regular lessons online. Attendance will be taken, as per usual, at the start of each lesson.

Junior Years students will be provided with a modified learning timetable and will carry out their learning through SEQTA or Class Dojo. Attendance will be taken at 8:45am.

Our teachers are going above and beyond to prepare meaningful online learning and assessment activities that students can engage with for the next week. Detailed information on your son's online learning program and key contacts will be provided tomorrow.

Please be assured that our priority is keeping our students and staff safe.

Parents and caregivers are asked not to enter the school grounds unless via prior arrangement and are advised that all bus services have been suspended. Parent/caregiver enquiries should be made via **8364 8200**.

We will continue to work under the guidance of Catholic Education SA and SA Health to ensure that we are doing all that we can to support the health and wellbeing of our community.
