# Duggan House

Throughout its history, Rostrevor College has been enriched by the contribution of boarders and their families from across Australia. Becoming a boarder at Rostrevor offers boys the chance to make the most of a range of extra opportunities that complement their development as young men, while establishing lifelong friendships with other boarders and their families.

Our boarding staff believe in developing a family spirit among the boarders who call Rostrevor home. They are committed to working with each boy to help him make the most of his time with us.

As a result of the recent refurbishment, Duggan House can provide individual room accommodation for 70 boarders. Duggan House welcomes enquiries from Year 7 to 12 families.



# Five Day Boarding

For some families, where distance is not so great, Rostrevor College offers students the opportunity to be a five-day boarder. Five-day boarding allows a student to go home for the weekend, returning to the College for commencement of the school week. Boarding fees will be on a pro-rata basis, by negotiation with the Principal or Business Manager.

# Fees

Boarding fees are based on full-year attendance in *Duggan House* and are a set fee in addition to tuition fees.

Boarding bursaries are available for some rural students, providing various levels of fee support, dependent on financial circumstances. Bursary applications should be made at the time of enrolment and completed with enrolment paperwork. The bursary paperwork should be forwarded to the College Business Manager, who will liaise directly with applicants.

Indigenous students must apply for an Indigenous boarding scholarship at the time of their enrolment. Indigenous boarding scholarships are subject to approval of Abstudy.
