### **First XI Match Report – 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2019**

A disappointing semi-final loss, although a much improved effort compared to the week before. This result just shows that we are still not at the level required across the three disciplines to compete with the very best sides in the competition.

We won the toss and elected to bowl and take advantage of the cooler conditions on a very hot day. Ben Homan started well and took two early wickets but again, we were too loose, offering the St Peter's batsmen at least one ball per over where they could score without risk. This had been a real focus of ours during the week, but some bowlers still need to bowl more accurately to really keep the pressure on which will restrict the runs and force wickets to fall.

In the middle overs, we pegged the St Peter's batsmen back well, with Kyle Brazell, Max Ramsey and Matt Dnistriansky consistently hitting the right areas. Mackenzie Best bowled the best that he has all season. With 3 overs to go, it was looking as if we would restrict St Peter's to 165, but we were really poor in the last 2 overs and allowed St Peter's to reach 186. This was still a total that we thought we could chase down.

Although we lost Stefan Lanzoni early, Christian Leddicoat and Kyle Brazell put on 48 for the second wicket and didn't look troubled. We did hit a lot of balls straight to fielders which made scoring a little more difficult. Both Brazell (runout) and Leddicoat (caught) fell in reasonably quick succession and from that point, the required run rate crept up and up. Some useful middle order runs from Ben Homan and Hank Burton were helpful, but at the end of the day, our top score was 35, which is not going to win many games of cricket.

We now have a third place play off fixture v Pembroke, which will be a great warm-up for Intercol at the end of March.
