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3. SUBJECT SELECTIONS

a) ELECTIVE UNITS: Our EDVAL timetabling program uses the **preferential system** to develop classes. Therefore, when you input your subject selections, you need to order them in **priority** of which **elective subject** you would like to study the most (preference #1) to your least preferred elective subject (preference #4). Use your electives research table and a discussion with your teacher and parents / caregivers to determine your elective preferences.

b) RESERVE UNITS: You must also nominate **two reserve subjects** in the event that one of your other selections cannot be fulfilled. **IMPORTANT** – you may get your reserve subject!

Please note Languages (Italian or Japanese) and Music are full year subjects, so take up two semesters (preferences) of choice. Students wishing to study either of these subjects in Year 10 need to complete a full year in Year 9. Enter either of these full year subjects by selecting Japanese A and Japanese B, Italian A and B, Music A and B.
