Announcement for Parents, Pastors, Staff and Students <u>De La Salle College, Revesby</u>

I am writing to advise you that after 11 years as Principal at De La Salle College, Revesby, Mr Tim Logue will be leaving our school community at the end of the 2021 school year and retiring from Sydney Catholic Schools after 44 years of service in Catholic Education, 40 of which were with Sydney Catholic Schools.

Mr Logue has been a dedicated educational leader who has cared for staff, students and their families with commitment and sensitivity. Throughout his tenure, Mr Logue has held various principal roles for an impressive 21 years, most notably leading All Saints Catholic Boys College in Liverpool as Principal before being appointed as the Principal at De La Salle College, Revesby.

In collaboration with Father Salas, Mr Logue has helped foster a Christ-centred community that is inclusive, welcoming and values families. His interpersonal and communication skills have enabled him to empower students, parents and staff, placing their concerns and wellbeing at the centre of his decision making. He has shown himself to be an excellent educational leader, focussed on building a strong learning culture within the community. I commend Mr Logue for his strong personal faith and his ability to foster positive relationships within the community.

I sincerely thank Mr Logue for his generous commitment to the wider educational community and his selfless leadership of De La Salle College, Revesby. On behalf of Sydney Catholic Schools, I would like to thank Mr Logue for his contribution to Catholic Education and the mission of the Church.

Finally, I wish to advise in the coming weeks that we will begin the process of recruiting the next Principal of De La Salle College, Revesby. This process will be conducted in consultation with the Parish Priest, Father Salas.
