Further to the Notices circulated by the Superior Court of Justice and Ontario Court of Justice on April 21, 2021 please see the comments below regarding Family Law matters.

Superior Court of Justice - 14B Motions

Regarding the PLA question: "Will 14B Motions be accepted?"

Response: "Acting RSJ Daley has looked into the question you have raised about 14B motions and wishes to advise that no motions have been rejected for filing other than where they are not compliant with the Family Law Rules.

There has been no direction to reject 14B motions."

Ontario Court of Justice (Family) - Mr. Justice Philip Clay, Local Administrative Justice (Family)

Regarding the Ontario Court of Justice Notice - April 21, 2021

Comments: "This directive has a big impact on the family court as we had a two week trial sitting on the now cancelled weeks of April 26 and May 3.

With one exception the matters scheduled for trial on this list have been adjourned to our next trial audit of July 21 for trials during the weeks of August 9 and 16. Currently there are three judges set for that list. It may be that a third week will be added to accommodate the extra trials and if so parties and counsel scheduled for the list will be notified.

All other family matters will continue as per the current pandemic schedule which means virtual hearings in all matters."
