WHAT IS BEING AUTOADJOURNED AND HOW?

Any trial, seized plea matter or other matters previously scheduled in courtrooms previously presided over by JUDGES (103, 209 Friday adult Prov / Fed PLEA, trial courts, 203 youth JPT/PLEA, 207 mental health, DTC, self-rep JPT's etc) continue to automatically adjourn pursuant to the Notice and presumptive adjournment dates published on the OCJ website (see link and [chart attached](#)).

In Brampton, these matters are traversed to 109 court every day to be auto adjourned.

Since 109 is now an in custody plea court, the flow of the day is largely governed by the jail who schedule in custody matters and is reserved for that purpose.

The court prefers counsel do NOT call in to address the auto adjournment matters.

Therefore, *unless there is another date already set up through the TC office* that you need to remand it to for a new trial date, motion, resolution etc, the matter will go over automatically.

In the meantime, *if you wish to move your matter forward*, contact the Crown to discuss the case and/or email the TC and request a new trial date or new plea / sentencing/ etc date, which can then be put on the record on the next presumptive adjournment date when you CAN and should call in for such purpose (or can request the matter be brought forward, as the case may be).
