Dear Parents and Children

By now you would be aware that schools will be fully open for normal classes tomorrow (Wednesday 28 July).

We look forward to seeing the children at school ready to start classes by 9.00 am.

As always, children should not attend school if they are unwell or are required to self-isolate/quarantine by SA Health. Please inform your child's teacher if you have not already done so. Only children in directed quarantine will be provided with learning support. Unfortunately we are unable to continue home-based learning unless your child is impacted by SA Health quarantine orders.

For our new Reception children and families, I understand how difficult this stop-start to school has been. Please be assured that your teacher will be attentive to the situation and if you have any questions please feel free to contact them.

Please note that some government restrictions are in place at present and this will mean normal access to the school site by parents will not be possible during this time. I therefore ask you to follow the guidelines below when dropping off and/or collecting your child from school:

- Children's access to the school will be via Carey Street or the Church car park gate – I ask that you please not send your children through the Front Office
- Only Reception children may be accompanied to their classroom by one parent who will need to be wearing a mask

Mask wearing is a new requirement by SA Health that has been mentioned in the media. While students in secondary schools will be required to wear masks, Primary school children are not required to do so.

As we transition back to schooling it will take time for all of us to adjust to the new requirements stipulated by the health authorities.

I also take this opportunity to remind you that if for any reason you have experienced financial difficulties and you are concerned about fees or other schooling costs, please contact me by email and I can arrange for the school to assist in your particular situation.

We look forward to the resumption of some routine and we are ready to welcome back your child tomorrow morning.
