Dear Parents and Caregivers

They must have thought going to school was the easiest thing ever; they were here for one day and then home for the next week. It was also the first day for their teachers Maddie McHugh and Kelly Adams. We welcome all of our Little Augustines and their teachers and hope they find our school to be a place of welcome and community.

Tuesday 20 July was also Michelle Thomas's first day with us. Michelle is our Acting Deputy Principal while Georgia Dennis is on leave. Welcome Michelle and thank you for your support and ability to see what needed doing in the last week of Lockdown.

As with everyone in South Australia, we are adhering to the advice and direction given to us by SA Health. At this moment, unfortunately that means no parents or caregivers on site. We know this is not ideal, but in our experience last year our children are very capable of developing their independence in these circumstances.

We would also like to reiterate our thanks to all of you for the past week.

For those of you in essential work, THANK YOU! In these uncertain times you were out there keeping our supermarkets and banks open for us, providing medical services in hospitals and testing and vaccination centres, keeping deliveries going, making sure our phones and internet didn't go down, providing mental health support, the list is long. You do all of this so that those who were staying inside their house had all they needed, and were as comfortable as possible under the circumstances. You are all HEROES.

For those of you who stayed at home trying to balance working from home and having children with school activities to accomplish, our hats go off to you and our hearts go out to you. You also made huge sacrifices for all of us to remain safe. THANK YOU! You are our unsung HEROES!

For the grandparents who suddenly had the grandchildren for an extended period. THANK YOU too! We could not have done this without you.

For our staff: ESOs, OSHC service and teachers. WOW! We do not have enough words. THANK YOU! Some of our staff were at the school for the children of essential workers, some worked from home, which is not an easy thing when children's learning is best face-to-face, they made phone calls to you to check in and make sure you were ok in your household. Some made phone calls and Dojo and SeeSaw messages to the families in our classes where the teacher was away last week. We are always most concerned if we have not been able to reach you and we keep trying.

Your children and your family's wellbeing is our most important concern. If everything is ok for you, then your children's learning is our next concern. We did not want them to struggle with their learning because of this latest Lockdown.

We are a beautiful community here at St Augustine's and we could not be more proud of the way everyone is doing the right thing, and helping each other through this.

It is so good to have the children back.

SAFETY NOTICE


