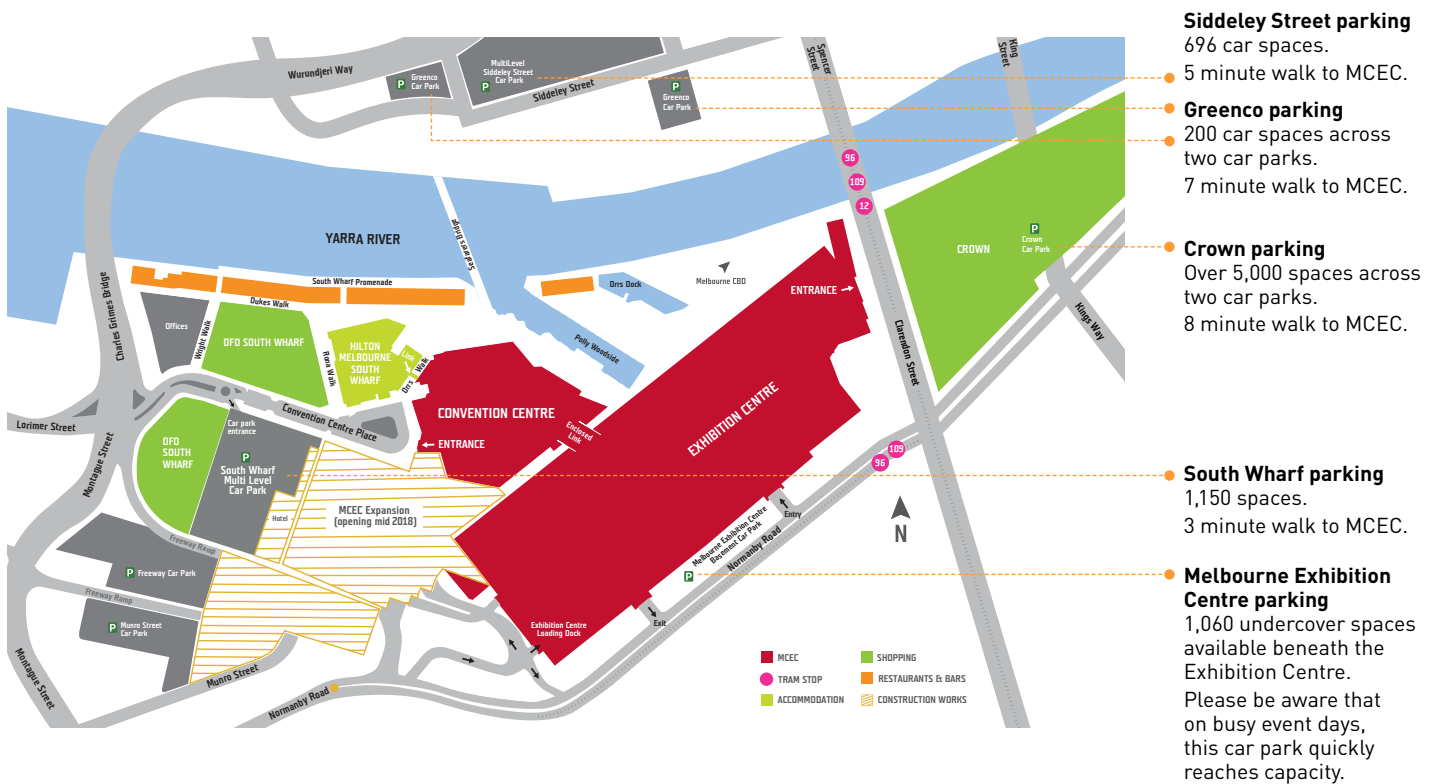
## WHAT MCEC'S EXPANSION MEANS FOR YOUR VISIT

You may have heard that Melbourne Convention and Exhibition Centre (MCEC) is expanding, adding a new building to offer more multi-purpose spaces for future events. Construction commenced in May 2016 and is expected to be completed by mid 2018.

We're working hard to ensure your visit is as hassle-free as possible. To help you plan your visit, we want to share some important updates about access and parking during construction.

### **PARKING:**

The new South Wharf multi-level car park is now open, adding an additional 1,150 spaces to the precinct. The new car park complements our existing parking area at Melbourne Exhibition Centre, Siddeley Street, Greenco, and Crown making a total of 8,106 parking spaces within MCEC vicinity.



### **ACCESS:**

The entry points to MCEC are operating as per usual. Signage and traffic management provisions are in place to help with traffic flow and directions in Convention Centre Place.

We're working with event organisers to minimise any disruption to our events.
