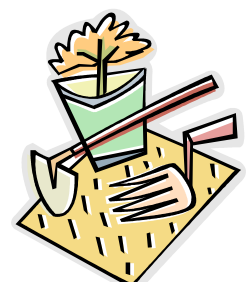
We need you!
