Bike and Road Safety Excursion

On Tuesday the IIth of February Room 14, Room 3, Room 18 and Room 10 went to the Road safety centre in Thebarton. We learnt about road and bike safety.

Some of the students thought the bike was too small, but the police officer told us that the perfect bike for you is the one where you sit on the seat and can reach the ground. In Australia people should ride their bike in the left lane. The GSPS students also practised using stop signs, give way signs and the red and green lights. Yellow lights mean slow down. Many of the little kids were ignoring the signs or riding in the right hand lane.

But adults even do that sometimes, it's not just us!


The classes rode the bikes for about half an hour and then they learned about road safety. They learned new things that they didn't know before. If you want to cross the road, don't cross at the bend or in the car park either. The best place to cross is the pedestrian crossing but always look left and right again before crossing. Also, when you are in the car, children need to sit in a booster seat until the seat belt fits properly. Children under 12 years should sit in

the back. Also did you know if you are 12 or under, you <u>can</u> ride on the footpath.
