New CBD High School

Details around the new DECD CBD High School, called Adelaide Botanic High School, have been announced.

The school will provide for 1250 students with a core focus on science, technology, engineering and mathematics. The construction of the school has begun and it is located adjacent to the Adelaide Park Lands, Botanic Gardens, the Adelaide Zoo, universities, the museum and State Library. It will be open from 2019 and welcome year 8 and year 9 students in its first year of operation.

The zoning associated with the school has also been announced. Adelaide Botanic High School and Adelaide High School will share a single zone, allowing parents within the zone to nominate their preferred choice of high school. Some students who attend Nailsworth Primary School will be part of the shared site. These students will be those living in Nailsworth, Medindie, Gilberton, Walkerville and Collinswood. Students living in Broadview or Sefton Park are not part of the single zone for the 2 CBD high schools.
