Every day - Practice Sounds & Tricky Words (via the Seesaw Links)

Reading - Each day please choose a decodable reader from Seesaw to practice sounding and blending and enjoy lots of picture books

Phonological Awareness - Check Seesaw for syllable, rhyme, beginning/middle/end sound activities, share Nursery Rhymes

Jolly Phonics

- Watch ng video on Seesaw
- Blend & write the ng words on paper with rainbow colours

Jolly Phonics

- Watch oo/00 video on Seesaw
- Blend & write oo/00 words by dipping your finger in water

Jolly Phonics

- Watch ch video on Seesaw
- Blend & write the ch words in the sand or dirt in your garden

Jolly Phonics

- Watch sh video on Seesaw
- Blend & make the sh words with letters or playdough etc

FUN Choice or Challenge

- Find the *Beginning Sounds 't' Challenge* in your Home Learning Book to complete
- Make a book, be creative
- Retell your favourite story, draw 2 characters
- Make a puppet of your favourite character

Writing

- Write 1-2 sentences about your holidays, draw a picture & upload to Seesaw

Writing

- Choose 3 Tricky Words and write them in colourful writing
- Complete sheet in home pack (photo of sheet on Seesaw)

Writing

- Describe what you have for lunch today
- Draw a picture and label it

Writing

- Choose a 'sh' word. Say it in a sentence. Stretch sounds to write the sentence. Repeat for 2 more. Draw pictures, upload to Seesaw

Outside Play/Exercise - be active, play games, be creative, spend time drawing, colouring, making, music, cooking etc.

Maths

- Home Challenge - Number
- Choose and draw 10 toys then label them from 1-10

Maths

- Watch Tuesday's 2D shape video from Seesaw
- Draw and label 2D shapes

Maths

- Missing numbers sheet
- Play number games with what number comes before/after

Maths

- Home Challenge - Shape
- Find different shaped objects outside and in your house

Maths

- Watch shape video on Seesaw
- Create a picture using shapes
- How many shapes did you use?

HASS

- Collect some Autumn leaves
- Sort by colours, size, shapes
- How do your leaves feel?

HASS

- Choose and draw a leaf
- *My leaf colour is... I like my leaf because...* (copy and write)

HASS

- Watch the story *We're going on a Leaf Hunt* on Seesaw
- Sing Baby Shark Autumn song

HASS

- Look at the photos on Seesaw
- Head outside: I see.. I hear.. I feel.. I taste.. I smell..

HASS

- Design and make a kite to fly on a windy Autumn day
- Try to use recycled materials

Music - Refer to the *Time to Sing* PDF on Seesaw, choose one rhyme or song to practice at home, share it with your family or a relative via Facetime

STEM - Choose an activity from the *30 Day Lego Challenge* grid to complete (pick your favourite creation to share on Seesaw/only 1 per week please)
